## The Loudest Shouts: An Overview of Christian History Dr. Michael A. Cox Original: 4-9-23

Text: Topical

**Central Idea of Message:** Belief in the literal, physical resurrection of Jesus Christ has been, and remains, the common denominator of Christianity in all of its expressions for nearly 2,000 years.

Introduction: I have preached Easter Sunday sermons from 1 Cor. 2-3 detailing the three categories of humans: the natural [unsaved], the carnal [saved], and the spiritual [saved], and then instructed each person present to ask themselves the personal question, "Who am I?"

Also, I have preached Easter Sunday sermons on hell from Luke 16 on Jesus' story about the rich man and Lazarus.

Additionally, I have preached Easter Sunday sermons encompassing the days in the life of Jesus leading to his arrest, trials, and crucifixion, and have done so many times in great detail.

Then, I have preached Easter Sunday sermons explaining the evidences for the literal, physical resurrection of Jesus Christ, going into great detail from an evidentialist's perspective as to why you and I should believe in the resurrection of Jesus and how this belief should impact our lives daily.

But today, on this particular Easter Sunday, I want to review three of the loudest shouts ever voiced in all of human history: "Crucify him," "It is finished," and "He has risen!" and then explain some of what has happened after the resurrection and after the proclamation, "He has risen!"

On this Easter Sunday, why don't we take a quick walk through the nearly 2,000 years of history since the resurrection and review what has happened by focusing on the spread of Christianity while filling in actual names, real dates, and factual places associated with Christianity for the last 1,993 years.
